There have been seven DeLoach family histories published, or circulated amongst DeLoach family historians. These are: _

Some Historic Families of South Carolina, by Frampton Earl Ellis. First published in 1905, republished in 1962. _
 Historic Southern Families, by John Bennett Boddie. This multi-volume set includes DeLoach family history in Volumes I, II, VII, and IX. _

DeLoach Family History, by Robert Ellis Colson. First published in 1965, revised on 15 October 1993. _

The DesLoges Family, by Joseph Earle Steadman. Published in 1981. _

History and Genealogy of the DeLoach Family, by Judge Harry DeLoach. Published in 1983 ? _

The DeLoach and Tison Family of South Carolina. Author and publication date unknown. _

Kershaw County Cousins, by Charlotte Boykin Salmond Brunson. Publication date unknown.

These publications trace the history of Michael DeLoach (Michel DesLoges), a French Huguenot refugee who arrived in Isle of Wight County, The Virginia Colony, in 1663. There is general agreement by the authors for the first few generations. One major difference is Thomas DeLoach. In his research, Steadman determined that Thomas was the son of Michel DesLoges. This change was included in the republication of Colson's book. This also lead to another major change. The first three publications indicated that Samuel DeLoach, born in about 1706, who later married Mary Boykin, was the son of William DeLoach and his wife Judith Wall. Steadman believed that Samuel was the son of the aforementioned Thomas. In a letter dated 3 Nov 1967 to Mr. J.T. DeLoach of Winnfield, Louisiana, Steadman writes,

"There is an error in Mrs. O'Donnell's record, in that she names the above mentioned Samuel as a son of the William DeLoach, Jr., and his wife (Judith Wall) who moved from Edgecombe County, N.C. to the Welsh Tract in Craven County S.C. in 1745. The said William (Jr), my wife's ancestor, and Samuel were first cousins and were about the same age. Samuel's father was Thomas DeLoach of Isle of Wight County, Va., and this Thomas was an uncle of William (Jr.)"

(Note - The Mrs. O'Donnell referred to is Mrs. James E. O'Donnell, whose mailing address in 1959 was P.O. Box 462, Woodville, MS).

In the Name of God Amen. I Samuell Deloach of Edgecombe County in the province of North Carolina - being weak in body but of sound mind and perfect memory Make This my last will and testament and make all others heretofore made by me Void first and principally I Commit my Soul into the hands of God that gave it and my body to the grave be buried in a nice Desant and Christian like manner.

Imprimis. I gave and bequeath to my beloved wife mary Deloach the land that my father in law [appears to have been erased, but looks like "left me in north hampton county"] Francis Boykin left me in northampton County to She and her heirs and assined forever - - - I further gave to my Wife mary Deloach my young black mair and Side Saddle to She and her heirs forever - - - I leve to my wife mary Deloach the keep of the land and plantan where on I now live and my still and all my nigros for the making maintaining and schoolin of my childrin During her life or whiddowhood and then to be devided by my executors according as my Will Dereacts - - - I further lend she my wife mary Deloach after my Debts and funralExpences is paid all my house hole goods and Chattles and all my tenements until my childrin comes of Eage and then to be devided and paidout by my ExR's - - according as my Will Dericts -

Item- I gave and bequeath to my Son William Deloach all that part of my estate I possessed him of in my lifetime and ten shillings cash to be paid him by my ExR's to him and his heirs forever

Item- I gave and bequeath to my Darter Averilla Ruffin all that part of my Estate I possed her of in my lifetime and ten shillings cash to be paid her by my ExR's - to she and her heirs forever - - -

Item- I gave and bequeath to my Darter Molley Braswell all that part of my Estate I possed her of in my lifetime and ten Shillings cash to be paid her by my ExR's to she and her heirs forever - - -

Item- I gave and bequeath to my son Jesse Deloach that tract of land that I sirvaid joining of mosses hairs land and my bay hose Cold Spark and five head of cattle and five breeding sows and one feather bead and furnurture which I gave to my son when he comes of Eage to be paid him by my ExR's to him and his heirs forever - - -

I further gave to my son Jesse Deloach after my wife deceas or whiddowhood my Negro fellow Ephram to him and his heirs forever - - -
