

William Boykin & Margaret Vicars Timeline in Isle of Wight Co., Virginia

- bef 1703 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** **William Boykin** was born.
- 18 May 1723 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** **Edward Boykin, Sr.**, of the upper parish to his son, **William Boykin** of the same, for Love and Affection?. -?- acres on the north side of Tuckers Swamp which runs into the main Blackwater Swamp on the west side and bounded by Cattail Branch (being part of the land said Boykin, Sr. bought from **Maj. Arthur Allen** and where **William Boykin** now lives and where **Thomas Boykin** did live). Wit: **John Worden** and **Thomas Giles**. Rec: 22 27 May 1723 Edward (x) Boykin (p.533) [NOTE: Incomplete reference.]
- 04 Jan 1725/6 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** **Edward Boykin** wrote his will. He gave his son **John** 530 acres. When his wife **Anne** died, the rest of his estate was to be divided among his other children (unnamed). They appear to be **Thomas, Edward Jr., and William**.¹ (Book 3, page 98) wife **Ann Boykin** and my son **John Boykin** Sole Executors.
- 27 May 1728 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** The will of **Edward Boykin** was probated. Leg: **Son: John**-plantation I live on and 530 acres. **Wife: Ann**, all the rest of estate-at her death equally divided among children. Wife **Ann** to have two negroes named **James & Luke** during her life and then to son **John**; Exec: wife and son **John Boykin**. Wit: **James Atkinson, Mary Atkinson, John Dunkley**.^{2,3}
- 08 May 1729 **Bertie Co., NC.** **James Speir** to **William Boykin** of Isle of Wight Co., Va., 21 lbs. for 220 A. On SS Moretock River adj. **John Nairne, William Gray, Henry Walker**. On Cattail Marsh at Hill Marsh. Wit: **John Speir, John Jones**. Rec. 13 May 1729. **Robert Forster C/C**.⁴
- 19 Jun 1731 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** **William Boykin** made his will. Wife **Margaret**, the plantation I bought of **Thomas Boykin** [named as his brother], sons: **Simon, William, John, Thomas**. Daughter **Martha** (at Roanoke land bought of **James Spears** to son William, land bought from brother Thomas Boykin to son John, land on Tucker's Swamp where **John Phillips** lived to son Thomas; land at Fishing Creek, North Carolina to the four sons.) Rec. 25 Sep 1732. Wit: **William Carrell, Thomas Moore Jr., M. Kinchin**.⁵ He had married Margaret, daughter of Ralph Vicars.⁶
- 25 Jun 1733 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** Appraisal of estate of **William Boykin** was recorded, by **John Dunkley, Francis Williamson, M. Kinchen**.⁷

- 24 Feb 1734 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** Account of the estate of **William Boykin** ordered recorded this date, made by **Thomas Vaughan**, who had married the Extx. (wife **Margaret**). Examined by **John Dunkley & Mathew Kinchin**.⁸
- 23 May 1737 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** Estate appraisal for estate of **William Boykin** was recorded, made by **John Dunkley, Thomas Gale**.⁹
- 10 Feb 1741 **Isle of Wight Co., VA.** **Ralph Vickers** made his will. Leg.-grandsons **Thomas & Simon Boykin**, the land which I bought of **Benjamin Boykin**; granddaughter **Martha Boykin**, daughter **Margaret Vaughan**, the wife of **Thomas Vaughan**. Ex., brother **Abraham Carnall**. Rec. 14 Jan 1747.¹⁰
