HUSBAND - Thomas Mann I

Information from John Bennett Boddie, Southside Virginia Families, Vol. 2, Genealogical Publishing Co., Baltimore, MD, 1956, reprinted 2008, p. 310. The following section was by William Marion Mann, Jr., and entitled "Descendants of Thomas and Elizabeth Mann of Isle of Wight."

"Thomas Mann, the ancestor of this family, was born in England about 1626 and emigrated to Virginia and settled in Nansemond County about 1648. On March 22, 1650, John Garwood was granted 1,000 acres of land in Nansemond County lying on the north side of the head of Indian Creek for transporting twenty persons to the colony. Among these twenty persons was this Thomas Mann (Cavaliers & Pioneers, p. 205). It was this same Thomas Mann who moved to Isle of Wight County, Virginia, and was assigned land by Richard Booth in 1681. However, since the records of Nansemond County have been burned, nothing of the early life of Thomas Mann in America is known."

NOTE: Her maiden name has not been proved.

CHILD 1 - Charles Mann

Charles never married apparently. When his father gave him 200 acres in 1681 the deed stipulated that if Charles died without issue, the land reverted to the heirs of Thomas Mann, Sr. (Will & Deed Book 1, pp. 473-474). Apparently, this was the land that Thomas Mann, Jr., sold 23 Feb 1690.

20 Apr 1680     Isle of Wight Co., VA. Richard Booth had sold his pat. of 550 acres to Thomas Man and wife Eliz. on 20 Apr 1680 in interest of John Rogers and Charles Man and made a correction in that document on 9 Feb 1692/3.[1]

08 Nov 1681     Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Man of Nansemond and Eliz. his wife give to their son Charles Man 20 acres in Lower Parish.[2]

23 Feb 1690     Isle of Wight Co., VA. A grant to Hodges Council, the younger, Thomas Mann of 200 acres. These assign to Wm. Kerle 09 Sep 1692.[3]

09 Feb 1692/3    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Richard Booth had sold his pat. of 550 acres to Thomas Man and wife Eliz. on 20 Apr 1680 in interest of John Rogers and Charles Man and made a correction in that document.[4]

13 Sep 1693     Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Man of I. of W., planter gives to Sarah Man, the wife of Francis Davis, 100 acres on Corowack Swamp along line of Charles Man. Wit.: William Duck, Margaret D\_\_\_. Also: by 1694 Sarah Mann and Francis Davis were married.[5]

13 Sep 1694     Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Man sells to James Curley 150 acres land next to James Johnson and Charles Man's Old field.[6]

Thomas Mann, Jr., and Bridgett Hooker Timeline

- Abt 1666        Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Mann, Jr., was born to Thomas Mann, Sr., & Elizabeth.
- abt Feb 1690    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Mann [Sr.] died. His estate was appraised by William Duck, John Watkins, Robert Johnson.[1]
- 07 Feb 1690    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas (X) Man [Jr.] of I. of W. sells to Henry Hearne of Nansemond 100 acres on Corowaugh Swamp adj. James Johnson. Teste: James (X) Bryan, Bridgeman Joyner, James Benn.[2]
- 23 Feb 1690    Isle of Wight Co., VA. A grant to Hodges Council, the younger, Thomas Mann of 200 acres. These assign to Wm. Kerle 09 Sep 1692.[3]
- 13 Sep 1693    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Man [Jr.] of I. of W., planter gives to Sarah Man, the wife of Francis Davis, 100 acres on Corowack Swamp along line of Charles Man. Wit.: William Duck, Margaret D\_\_\_\_.[4] Also: by 1694 Sarah Mann and Francis Davis were married.[5]
- 13 Sep 1694    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Man [Jr.] sells to James Curley 150 acres land next to James Johnson and Charles Man's Old field.[6]
- 08 Nov 1696    Bertie Co., NC. Thomas Man, heir of Thomas Man lately deceased, sold 550 acres on Corowak Swamp to Nichols Tynes for 200 pounds of tobacco.[7] Wit.: Boaz Gwin, Phillip Rayford.[8]
- 09 Feb 1697    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Thomas Mann, heir of Thomas Mann, deceased, sold his remaining interest in his father's land patent that had been granted 22 Sep 1682 to William Butler. Wit.: Richard Reynolds, Joyner Reynolds.[9] Another reference give name as Joyce Reynolds.[10]  
  
The patent to Mann is for land in Isle of Wight, but appears to be actually in Nansemond. Either way, it was close to what is now the North Carolina line (the boundary was uncertain in those days). It appears to be quite close to what was evidently the land of Richard Staples.[11]
- 30 Mar 1700    Chowan Co., NC. Thomas Mann [Jr.] had 640 acres surveyed, which grant he had applied for in 1699.[12]
- 12 Dec 1701    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Wm. Fowler sells to Benj. Beale for 3000 lbs. tbco. 100 acres granted to John Drake late of the county, dec., and by him deserted and since granted to Will. Fowler, 21 Oct 1690, granted to my father, Wm. Fowler and, I, as son and heir of said Wm. Fowler, now dead, sell land adj. Thos. Mann [Jr.], Hodges Council & Col. Bridger. Wit.: Arthur Whitehead, Chris Reynolds.[13]
- 25 Feb 1703/4    Isle of Wight Co., VA. Mark (X) Alsbury of Nansemond sells to Thomas Page of I. of W. 170 acres on Currowaugh Swamp adj. Robert Carr and Thomas Mann. Wit.: Wm. Parker, Mary (X) Parker, J. Gay.[14]
- abt 1684        Chowan Co., NC. Thomas Mann [Jr.] and Bridgett Hooker were married.[15]
- 18 Jul 1713    Chowan Co., NC. Part of a deed: Thomas Mann and Bridgett Mann to Henry Barnes assignment of 320 acres out of 640 in this patent belonging to ye Mannor Plantation.[16]
- 06 Oct 1714    Chowan Co., NC. Edward Bryan of Chowan Prect. to John Bryan of the Prect. afrsd. £14 current passable money of ye province 320 acres on ye west side of Chowan river part of a

26 Mar 1723      Chowan Co., NC.    George Williams [Jr.] 260 acres lying in the fork 'twixt the South and Middle branches of Cassay, joining Thomas Man [Jr.] and the bottom of the neck where the two branches meet.    Wit: Wm Reed, F. Foster, R. Sanderson, J. Lovick, M. Moore.[19]    George Williams, Jr., married Sarah Mann, daughter of Thomas Mann, Jr., and Bridgett Hooker.

30 Sep 1735      Bertie Co, NC.    Thomas Mann made his will, proved at the November Court, 1735. Leg.- son John "My plantation and six hundred and forty acres of land." To his son Thomas [III] he bequeathed a plantation on Wickacone Creek. To his cousin William Crawman he left land on Killam Swamp. Thomas named his daughters Mary Mann and Bridget Griffin as well as his wife Bridgett in his will. Also named was his grandson George Williams [III].
